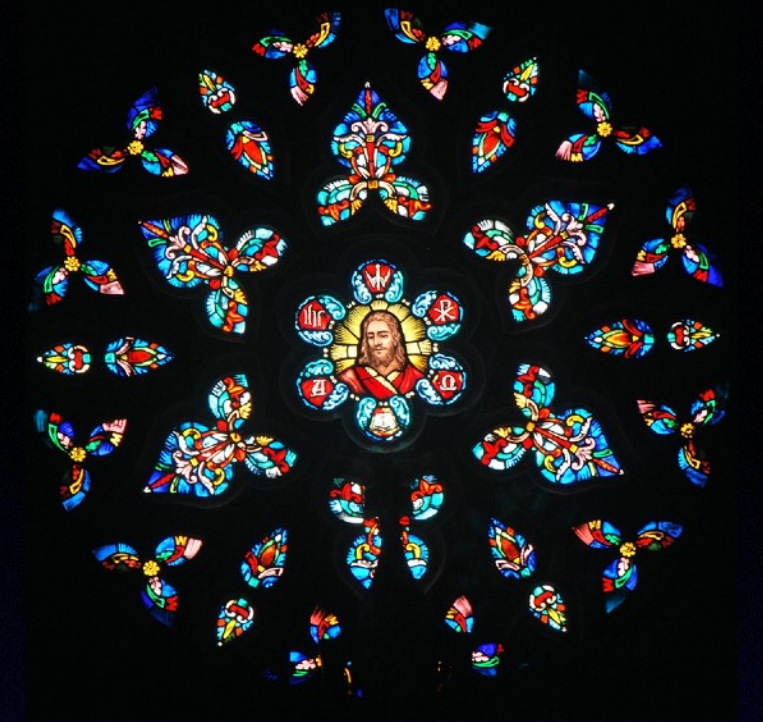

Speak to us, Lord; your flock listens now for your voice.

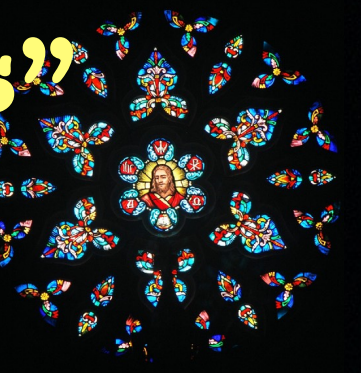

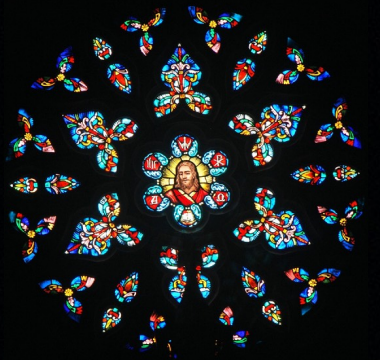
**You, Creator God, have written

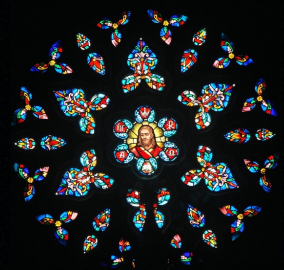
